WORKING THROUGH PARENTING CONFLICT CLASS (WTPCC)

In 2010, the Juvenile Court implemented the <u>Working Through</u> <u>Parenting Conflict Class</u>. Participation in the class is ordered by the Court, either at the discretion of the judge or magistrate or when one of the parents petitions the Court for assistance when there are conflicts relating to custody or visitation.

This class, offered once a month, is taught and managed by two professional mediators, one of whom is a licensed psychologist. Parents are generally ordered to attend the class one time. Each parent is ordered to pay a \$30 fee for the cost of the supplies and instructors.

The <u>WTPCC</u> class has generated many positive comments from those parents who attend. Attendees have indicated that the class benefits them in providing alternative ways to handle conflicts that may arise in custody or visitation issues.
